<b>Sun Jan 14<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Retribution</b>	<u>6.7 million</u> viewers overall
<b>Sun Jan 21<sup>st</sup></b>	<b>Shattered</b>	At 10 p.m. ET, "Crossing Jordan" (2.4/5 in 18-49, <u>7.6 million</u> viewers overall) was up 9 percent in 18-49 and 14 percent in total viewers versus its week-ago performance, despite NFL playoff competition.
<b>Sun. Jan 28<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>33 bullets</b>	At 10 p.m. ET, "Crossing Jordan" (2.7/7 in 18-49, <u>7.9 million</u> viewers overall) hit its highest numbers in its three telecasts so far this season. In 18-49, "Crossing Jordan" was up 13 percent versus the prior week and up 23 percent versus the week before that. "Jordan" ranked #2 in adults 18-49 and #1 among women 18-49 and adults, men and women 18-34
<b>Sun. Feb 11<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Crazy Little Thing Called Love</b>  <b>('Las Vegas' Cross Over)</b>	At 10 p.m., "Crossing Jordan" (2.5/6 in 18-49, <u>8.1 million</u> viewers overall) delivered its highest overall total viewership so far this season, despite competition from the "Grammy Awards" on CBS.
<b>Sun Feb 18<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Mr. Little and Mr. Big</b>	<u>7.0 million</u> viewers overall.
<b>Sun Feb 25<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Night of the Living Dead</b>	"Crossing Jordan" (2.3/5 in 18-49, <u>6.7 million</u> viewers overall) built on its 18-49 lead-in by 77 percent. Despite competition from the Academy Awards telecast, "Jordan" finished within 0.2 of an 18-49 rating point of its result for the previous Sunday.
<b>Wed Mar 7<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Hubris</b>	At 9 p.m., "Crossing Jordan" (2.4/6 in 18-49, <u>8.1 million viewers overall</u> ) debuted in its new night and time period, building by 26 percent in 18-49 versus its lead-in.
<b>Wed Mar 14<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Isolation</b>	'At 9 p.m., "Crossing Jordan" (2.1/5 in 18-49, <u>7.4 million viewers overall</u> ) finished within 12 percent of last week's results in 18-49 rating, despite the arrival of "American Idol" in the 9 p.m. half-hour.'
<b>Wed Mar 21<sup>st</sup></b>	<b>Seven Feet Under</b>	'At 9 p.m., "Crossing Jordan" (1.7/4 in 18-49, <u>6.1 million viewers overall</u> ) increased by 27 percent in 18-49 rating from its first to its second half-hour.'
